

Code of Conduct For French Camping Trip

1. Common sense is your best guide, we don't want reams of rules, if you think about your behaviour, you know what is right & wrong.
2. To be courteous & polite are foundations of all good behaviour, especially when you are an ambassador of your school & country.
3. Instructions must be followed without argument or challenge.
4. Drinking of alcohol & smoking are strictly forbidden.
5. Pupils are not allowed in the tents of the opposite sex, except at social times & then only in-groups.
6. Noise in a campsite can be a problem especially at night, please show consideration for other campers at all times.
7. You are not allowed to wander off around the campsite or ferry unsupervised. Stay with your group at all times.
8. Check before you purchase gifts, some I will not allow you to bring back.
9. You are not allowed to use the swimming pools & or slides without permission & direct supervision from a member of MCS staff.
10. Campsite activity facilities, like the tennis courts & adventure playground are out-of-bounds unless you have been given express permission to be there & are under direct supervision.
11. Accompanying adults are voluntary staff of MCS. You must follow their instructions.

If, in the opinion of the tour company and their representatives, coach drivers, campsite manager, members of staff or any person in authority, your son/daughter behaves in such a way as to cause danger, distress or annoyance to others or damage property, their holiday arrangements may be terminated. In this situation the school will have no liability to you and will not be responsible for making any refunds, paying compensation or meeting any costs or expenses incurred as a result. Further, you must meet any expenses incurred as a result of their behaviour.

Local laws & socially acceptable behaviour are different to our own, we are under their rules when in their country, take care!
