As we draw to the end of our 2012/2013 academic year, it is time for the annual, highly popular and successful, London Trip! And this year, it's a bit of an epic one as sadly, it will also be my last trip before I leave. So we're pulling out all the stops!

The exact timings will be firmed up closer to the date as we will be basing the mode of transport on the number of students we have and what makes most sense.

Provisionally, the plan is to get the train from Exeter St Davids at 6/7am to arrive in London Paddington for 10/11am. From there we will take the Tube to the London Zoo in Regent's Park, one of the country's top Zoos. After spending a few hours here we will take the Tube down to Waterloo to visit the new London Dungeons, which have moved since our visit there in 2011 and should offer a new experience to any who were there before. After this we will make our way toward the theatre and enjoy some food in an eating establishment of the student's choice around Leicester Square. From there we will travel to attend the 7:30pm showing of the hit musical Wicked, after which we will travel back home, arriving at the unreasonable hours of the morning.
