Three Blind Mice

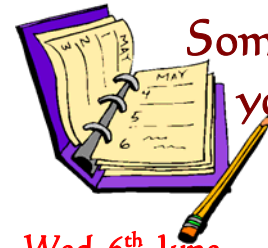
Three blind mice, three blind mice,
