The aim is for high academic performance and an enrichment programme with an early GCSE strategy, is in place for bright and gifted children, alongside a powerful support department which caters for dyslexia, dyscalculia and other specific learning difficulties.

Magdalen Court School has had some outstanding successes with early GCSE examinations of late. Timothy Hackett in year nine, achieved an A\* in Expressive Arts and Brendan Murphy, who is also in

year nine, gained a B grade in Maths.

Science, Maths, Art and Sport, which often takes place in the school's full-sized sports hall, are all keenly developed in the children, along with music and a clear focus on the Theatrical Arts.

The choir is especially popular and singing is undertaken in both French and Latin. There are six theatrical presentations each year varying from informal verse speaking and singing events through to dramatic productions such as *Annie* and *Bugsy Malone*.

Outward Bound activities hold a very special place at Magdalen Court School. The school usually undertakes a series of walks leading

up to the Ten Tors, where medals have been won each year.

Swimming and canoeing are highly popular activities. The school undertakes the British Canoe Union awards and encourages pupils to progress towards their coaching assessments.

Magdalen Court School has a small and highly individual sixth form where students are usually enrolled as Senior Prefects. The school offers first-time A-level courses as well as one-term and one-year retake courses for both A-level and GCSE.

Mention must be made of the four Nursery classes which are structured on a gentle formal basis to promote a sound beginning to a child's education.
